# Additional Costs

- Arranging electronic verification of your identity: £10-£20 plus VAT per individual
- Arranging file storage: £25 plus VAT
- Arranging electronic transfer of monies: £40 plus VAT per transfer (there can be additional charges where monies are sent internationally)

# Additional Expenses

Payments we make to third parties on your behalf to ensure a smoother process may be applicable for Grant of Probate and Full Estate Administration services. These may include:

- Probate Application Fee: £273 (no VAT)
- Additional sealed copies of the Grant: £1.50 (no VAT) per copy
- Bankruptcy Only Land Charges Department searches: £2.40 (inclusive of VAT) per individual
- HM Land Registry Official copies £3.60 (inclusive of VAT)
- Notice in the London Gazette and a local newspaper (to protect against unexpected claims from unknown creditors): Varies but usually no more than £200 (inclusive of VAT) for both

# VAT is charged at the current standard rate of 20%

#### **Professional Executors**

Where Member Partners of this firm have been appointed to act as Professional Executor/s, where applicable, their time spent working on the matter will be charged at their hourly charge out rate, which varies between approximately £230 and £300 plus VAT per hour.

#### Is the estate taxable?

\*The exact costs will depend on the individual circumstances of the matter, for example a modest estate with no property and one beneficiary is likely to be at the lower end of the scale. Whereas a large estate with multiple properties, accounts, assets and beneficiaries will be at the higher end of the cost scale.

\*\*This quote is based on us handling the full process for you and assumes the estate has: a valid will, no more than one property, no more than five bank accounts or building society accounts, no other intangible assets, there are between 1 and 5 beneficiaries, there are no disputes between beneficiaries, no inheritance tax is payable, there is no need for the executors to submit a full account to HMRC and there are no claims made against the estate. There are likely to be additional costs if there is no will in place, the estate consists of shareholdings and/or if additional copies of the grant are required, or any of those involved in the matter are uncooperative / unduly delay. Dealing with the sale or transfer of any property within the estate is not included, but our Property Law Team would be able to provide you with a competitive quote for this work.

## Timescale

The general timescale for a straightforward probate is 6 – 12 months and roughly between 12 – 26 hours at our team's hourly rates.
